

Cookies Policy

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This enables the University to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to take steps to improve our website. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- Strictly necessary cookies these are required for the operation of our website. These
 include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website or
 use a shopping cart.
- Analytical/performance cookies these allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors to our website and see how visitors move around our website when they are browsing. This helps us improve the way in which our website works, for example, by ensuring that users can find what they are looking for easily.

The table below includes the types of cookies we use and the purposes for which they are used:

Essential Site cookie	ASP.NetSessionId	This cookie is essential for the operation of our website. This is a unique user ID which is given to every user to help the website maintain session information. This cookie is deleted as soon as you leave the University website.	Not applicable
Non- essential Site cookie	Not applicable	This cookie is used to provide us with information on the pages you visit on our website. This information helps us provide off-site digital advertising to provide you with information which may interest you.	Not applicable
